- Presently enrolled as a full-time student in any accredited college, university or vocational-technical school or training institution and is meeting the passing criteria for that institution.
- Been accepted into an accredited college, university, or vocational-technical school or training institute.
- During enrollment, maintain a grade point average that meets the passing criteria for that institution and be enrolled on a full-time status (twelve or more credit hours),
- Applicant must be registered to vote in their State of residence.

The Following Supporting Documents Are Required (please attach to application):

- Official school transcript from the school you are currently attending or last school attended. Photocopies are not acceptable.
- Certified copy of birth certificate,
- Proof of voter registration,
- Admission confirmation letter (copy acceptable),
- Tuition statement that includes scholarships awarded and financial services contact information,
- Two letters of recommendation (teachers, professors, guidance counselor, school advisor, clergy, mentor, Labor or Business leader),
- TypeWritten statement (300 words or more) addressing the following: "My goal in life is"
- Recent photograph (must be headshot) to be used on any and all LIUNA Midwest Region media sources if applicant is chosen as a scholarship recipient.
